General Information

Reminder for Parents: All children under 8 years old need to be accompanied by an adult to play in the Lake Naomi Clubhouse Game Room.

Speeding Notice: The speed limit in Timber Trails is <u>25</u> <u>MPH</u>. Frequently in our haste to make a tee time, tennis lesson, or other activity we tend to ignore this limit. In order to help prevent potentially tragic accidents, we are asking everyone to please SLOW DOWN.

Lake Naomi Clubhouse Dress Code:

Attire: In order to maintain the quality experience that the Members expect at the Lake Naomi Clubhouse, Club Members and Guests should wear appropriate attire when dining at the Lake Naomi Clubhouse. Jackets are not required but they are welcomed at all times. The Main Dining Room and Tall Timbers Room: Gentlemen must wear a collared shirt or a comparable dress shirt at all times. Beach attire, T-shirts, cutoffs, tank tops and hats are not permitted at any time. Except for special functions where they are appropriate (for example, square dances and western night), blue denim jeans are not permitted on Saturday nights. The Grill Room: Gentlemen are requested to wear a collared shirt or a comparable dress shirt at all times. In the summer, if entry is from the deck in beach attire, a cover-up and shoes are required. Cut-offs, tank tops, and hats are not permitted. The Outdoor Deck: Beach attire, cut-offs, hats and jeans are permitted. Please inform your guests of these policies before they arrive at the Clubhouse. In the event of questionable attire, the decision of the Clubhouse Management will be final.

<u>Paintings in Clubhouse</u> - The Pocono Mountain Arts Council is displaying paintings by local artists in the Clubhouse. The paintings are for sale and a price list may be obtained from June Schott at 646 - 0379.

Fishing in Lake Naomi - The Lakes Committee encourages LIVE RELEASE of all trout. All bass and walleye must be alive when released. Take special care to not over tire, squeeze, or injure the fish. If possible, keep the fish in the water and gently remove the hook and release when fish is revived. If fish is deeply hooked, simply cut your line. Releasing these species not only increases reproduction but allows them to provide your sport another day.

INFORMATION

Staff Limitations - Staff Members leaving for school commitments will make it difficult for the Club to fully staff all of its operations during the last two weeks of the Summer Season. This factor may result in the temporary closing of some facilities and/or the reduction in services at some facilities. Your cooperation and understanding in this matter will be most appreciated.

Facility Closings - Club Beach and Lake Naomi will be OPEN for regular hours through Labor Day. All other beaches will be closed as of Monday, August 30th. Timber Trails Pool will be closed Monday, August 30 through Thursday, September 2nd and will reopen Friday, September 3rd through Monday, September 6 for the Labor Day Holiday.

Golf Fall Season - The Timber Trails Golf Course and the Pro Shop will be open the following hours through October 31st.

Fall Tennis Hours of Operation -

Lake Naomi Tennis Center - This facility will be open Saturdays and Sundays from 8am - 1pm after the Labor Day Weekend through until Columbus Day Weekend. Reservations for play may be made by leaving a message at 646 - 7580 between 10am and Noon on Fridays. Courts are available for walk on play Monday - Friday. Please see the por shop door signage for more information.

Timber Trails Tennis - This facility will be staffed from 8am - 12:30pm on Friday, August 27th through Sunday, August 29th and will be closed in the afternoons. As of Monday, August 30th, courts will be available for walk - on play from 8am - Noon through Monday, September 6th. These courts will be closed for the season as of Tuesday, September 7th.

Recreation Tennis Courts - Any member interested in using the recreation tennis courts by North Beach after Labor Day will need to stop by the AO to pick up a key. A \$5 deposit is required for key pickup and refunded when the key is returned.

Timber Trails Pool - The Timber Trails Pool will once again be open for two weekends beyond Labor Day. The pool will be open from 11am - 5pm on Saturday September 11th; Sunday, September 12th; Saturday, September 18th; and Sunday, September 19th. This extended pool season will be available to all Club Members. Club Members who do not choose to subscribe to the Pool Club Membership will be asked to contribute \$5 per person or \$10 per family per day for this special service.

Fall and Winter Clubhouse Hours - This fall and winter season (September 6th, 2004 through March 12th, 2005), the Clubhouse is open on Thursdays, Fridays, Saturdays and Sundays through October 1st only. The schedule is as follows:

Breakfast - Served only on Sundays through October 10th from 9am - Noon. Breakfast is served from a buffet only.

Dinner -

6pm - 8pm Thursday Pasta Buffet 6pm - 9pm Fridays and Saturdays

Bar -

5pm - 9pm Thursdays 5pm - 11pm Fridays 6pm - 10pm Saturdays

9am - 12pm Sundays (during scheduled breakfast buffets)

Boat Racks and Watercraft Pick - up - All watercrafts must be removed from boat racks by the Monday of Columbus Day Weekend (Monday, October 11th). Watercrafts must be moved to private storage locations during the off - season in order to facilitate winter maintenance of the shoreline. Any watercrafts left after this date are subject to pick - up and storage fees. The service fee boat pick - up is \$50. If the watercraft is not claimed within 7 days, an additional storage fee of \$10 per week will be charged. If the watercraft is not claimed within three months, the Club may sell or dispose of it.
