## **General Information**

#### DATES AND TIMES

Kids Klub takes place Monday thru Friday 9:00AM - Noon beginning June 28th through August 20th. Campers may be dropped off at their appropriate locations after 8:50AM. Campers must be picked up within 10 minutes of the program ending, including returning from trips.

#### REGISTRATION

Pre-registration is required and closes at Noon each Friday prior to the next week of camp. A Kids Klub Registration Form and birth certificate (if applicable) for each child must accompany payment and be turned in to the Lake Naomi Club Administration Office.

#### AGES

Children 4 to 13 (inclusive). A child must be four years of age in order to attend KIDS KLUB. Counselors cannot provide individualized or specialized care.

#### **GROUPS**

Each child will be assigned to one of six different KIDS KLUB groups. These groups are set by age level and/or grade level. The Kids Klub Director will have the final say as to which group each child will be assigned.

#### LOCATION

Tobyhanna Elementary Center (TEC) for "A-E" Groups (4-11 year olds) & Beaver Brook Recreation Center (BBRC) for "F" Group (12 & 13 year olds).

#### ACTIVITIES

Daily Art & Crafts Projects (both group and individual), Sports & Games, Wildlife & Nature Activities, off property trips to other LNC venues are all part of The KIDS KLUB PROGRAM.

#### **ACCIDENTS AND INJURIES**

Please make sure your child reports all injuries to our staff so that we can take care of them properly and notify you if necessary.

#### PHONE

The KIDS KLUB directors can be reached during KIDS KLUB hours at 646-9832. Please limit use of Kids Klub phone for Camp business and emergency situations. Messages may be left at the Administrative Office at 646-9191 for any of our staff members seven days a week, 9:00AM - 4:45PM.

#### DRESS

Children should come dressed for active play. Sneakers are highly recommended. Don't forget a jacket, sunscreen and bug spray when needed. It may also be beneficial to send in an old shirt for your child to wear during art activities.

#### FIELD TRIPS

Six field trips have been scheduled for KIDS KLUB 2004. Field trips are optional and any child who does not wish to go on field trips will still be able to attend KIDS KLUB on the days that the trips are scheduled. You may register at one time for all trips and pay with one check payable to Lake Naomi Club. Registration and payment for trips will only be accepted at Kids Klub. Please note the age or height restrictions on some of the trips. Please be sure to fill out separate permission slips for each trip. However, if you have more than one child attending a trip you may write all of their names on one slip per trip.

### FIELD TRIPS

The following field trips have been scheduled for KIDS KLUB 2004. Field trips are optional and any child who does not wish to go on a trip can still attend KIDS KLUB on the days field trips are scheduled.

#### CAMELBEACH WATER PARK FRIDAY, JULY 16™

From 9:00 AM – 4:30 PM. Cost is \$24 per child. For D, E, & F group children who are at least 36 inches tall. Children will need to bring a bag lunch, swimsuit, towel and sun block. This day of summer fun includes unlimited use of the water attractions, bumper boats, swimming pool, miniature golf and wave pool for those over 48 inches. Camelbeach is located in Tannersville, approximately 30 minutes away. Pre-registration is required by Thursday, July 15th. This trip is limited to the first 60 children who register.

# POCONO ENVIRONMENTAL EDUCATION CENTER FRIDAY, JULY 23<sup>RO</sup>

From 9:00 AM – 2:30 PM. Cost is \$20.00 per child and for all ages. Children of all ages will appreciate the wonder of nature at the PEEC located within the boundaries of the Delaware Water Gap National Recreation Area. (Approximately 1 hour away.) The PEEC offers a wide variety of activities including: playing games to learn animal behaviors, doing scavenger hunts to learn about natural habitats, taking scenic hikes, and learning how to find compass points on an established course. There is something for all ages and each age group will do appropriate activities planned for them. Children should bring their own lunch and wear sneakers or appropriate footwear. (NO sandals or flip-flops please.) This trip is limited to the first 80 who register. Each child must have a special waiver completed to participate in this trip which may be picked up at Kids Klub or the Administrative Office.

# STOURBRIDGE LINE RAIL EXCURSIONS FRIDAY, JULY 30TH

From 9 AM – 2:30 PM. Cost is \$10.00 per child and for all ages. Children will enjoy a private train ride for KIDS KLUB as they travel back in time and see what is left of an old canal, its retaining walls and old coal pockets. Many species of wildlife can be spotted along this trip including bears! Located in Honesdale, PA (about an hour away), this is the birthplace of the American Railroad. Children should bring a bag lunch as half way through the train ride we will get off the train and eat in the park. Pre-registration is required by Thursday, July 29th. This trip is limited to the first 80 who register.

# CLAWS 'N' PAWS WILD ANIMAL PARK FRIDAY, AUGUST 6TH

From 9 AM – 3 PM. Cost is \$12.00 per child and for A, B & C group children. Claws 'N' Paws is a wild animal park with over 120 rare and exotic species in a natural wooded setting. Children will enjoy seeing all types of animals including giraffe, monkeys, panthers, bears, reptiles and more! Located in Hamlin, PA, Claws 'N' Paws is approximately an hour away. Children should bring a bag lunch. Pre-registration is required by Thursday, August 5th. This trip is limited to the first 60 who register.

## BIG WHEEL ROLLER SKATING THURSDAY, AUGUST 12TH

From 9:30 AM – 1:30 PM. Cost is \$15.00 per child and for all ages. Big Wheel Roller Skating Rink will be hosting a private skating party for KIDS KLUB. Cost of this trip includes regular skate rental, slice of pizza, and a drink. Children are welcome to bring their own skates and protective gear. In-line skates are available for an additional \$3 rental, but sizes are limited. The snack bar will be open, so children may bring extra money for other snacks. Big Wheel is located in East Stroudsburg, PA approximately 45 minutes away. Pre-registration is required by Wednesday, August 11th. This trip is limited to 80 children.

# DELAWARE WATER GAP NATIONAL RECREATION AREA CAMPGROUND EXCURSION WEDNESDAY, AUGUST 18™ AND THURSDAY AUGUST 19™

This is an overnight trip and available to "F" group only. Cost is \$75 and includes overnight accommodations, professional programming, transportation, lunch and dinner for Wednesday and breakfast Thursday morning. Meet at the BBRC, August 18th at 9:30 AM for a departure of 10:00 AM. The Delaware Water Gap National Recreation Area is about an hour away so we will arrive around 11:00 AM and drop of

A variety of activities are offered including canoeing, hiking, searching for fossils and best of all, a natural setting to explore. Bring all of your outdoor gear and prepare to explore the land, swim under the waterfalls, and sing campfire songs into the night. We will leave the Water Gap at approximately 10:30 AM on Thursday to arrive in time for Kids Klub pick up for that day. Pre-registration is required by Tuesday, August 16th. This trip is limited to 35 children, so please sign up

early. An additional flyer will be provided with the specific details of the trip.


## **Shuttle Bus Information**

Lake Naomi Club Shuttle Bus Service will again be available for transportation to and from KIDS KLUB. A KIDS KLUB Counselor will be on the bus during these times. If an emergency should arise which prevents you from meeting the bus, your child will remain on the bus with the counselor and return to the Administrative Office at approximately 1:00 PM upon completion of the route. A KIDS KLUB staff member will remain with your child until proper arrangements can be made. For their safety, we can not release your child to anyone but a parent without a written notification from you.

Please Note: As camp attendance increases it is necessary to have a second bus transport children home after camp. The route is separated and the second bus takes the children in and close to Timber Trails. For this reason, some stops have different times in weeks two though eight. These stops are italicized and in green ink. Please be mindful of these time changes.

A map is enclosed and shows the Lake Naomi/Timber Trails Shuttle Bus route. Each bus stop on the bus schedule has been assigned a number. This number corresponds to the map and shows where each bus stop is located.

On the days that extended field trips are scheduled, the shuttle bus will run immediately upon return for drop off.
